Players: Players are required to wear shin guards to play. Soccer cleats are not required. Baseball or Football cleats are not acceptable since they have toe cleats which are not allowed in soccer. No jewelry may be worn. This includes earrings in newly pierced ears or bandages coverings. **No exceptions.**

JCPRD jerseys must be worn at all times during league games. If you are a new player or and existing player needing a larger size, or you are moving to a team with a different color, **you must purchase a jersey for \$15.** All players moving up from pee wee to 1st grade must purchase new JCYS jersey.

Pee Wee teams wear reversible red/blue jerseys. JCYS teams are assigned a jersey color.

Antioch Park – Coaches will be notified of time. All JCPRD coaches are required to attend. Team rosters, schedules and jerseys will be distributed. All coaches and assistant coaches must have a background check and volunteer Hold Harmless forms on file before season games begin. Please send assistant coach or team representative if head coach is unavailable to attend.

COACHES & REFEREES NEEDED!

If you are interested in coaching your child's team, please check the box at the bottom of your child's registration form. Returning Coaches from Spring 09 submitting registrations for a team, do not need to include a registration fee. If you are requesting to be a new coach, please include payment for your child's fee, if you are selected as Coach, you will be refunded your payment.

As part of the risk management process, JCPRD (the "District") checks criminal history records on individuals for employment with the District, including seasonal hires and volunteers who will work with children, individuals with disabilities and/or persons with frail and fragile physical circumstances or preconditions, or other circumstances as the District deems necessary. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win. **I will de-emphasize winning or losing attitude towards opposing team/coaches and focus on fun and participation.**

I will support coaches and officials in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all. **The Referee is in charge of the game.**

I will never criticize the referee openly or directly during games. **Before you attempt to interpret the Laws of the Game be sure you know and understand them.** (We are always in need of Referees. if you are knowledgeable with the rules please volunteer your time to Referee.)

I will not coach the players from the sidelines. I will let the Coaches do the Coaching. (Players are confused if everyone is yelling instructions to them.)

I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

Making mistakes is part of the learning process—don't criticize.

I will make youth sports fun for my players.

I understand that the *Game is For the Kids* – it is not for the adults.

If a parent/spectator is found violating any of the above, he/she may be asked to leave the field. Since the Coach is responsible for the actions of the parents/spectators, he will be carded and this may result in suspension of his/her coaching duties.
