Pee Wee teams wear reversible red/blue jerseys. JCYS teams are assigned a jersey color.

Teams: Teams are based on players birthdates. Please check Age Brackets at www.jcprdsoccer.com In order to keep teams together we request that coaches submit all individual registrations together along with Team Info form "Green sheet" which can be found at www.jcprdsoccer.com .

Players: Players are required to wear shin guards to play. Soccer cleats are not required. Baseball or Football cleats are not acceptable since they have toe cleats which are not allowed in soccer. No jewelry may be worn. This includes earrings in newly pierced ears or bandages coverings. **No exceptions.**

Coach Team Packet Pick up

Coaches can pick up their Team packets at Antioch Park, Bldg A on March 6, 9am-12:00. A short meeting will be held for new coaches at 10am. Team packets include rosters, schedules and jerseys. All coaches and assistant coaches must have a background check and volunteer Hold Harmless forms on file before season games begin. Please send assistant coach or team representative if head coach is unavailable to pick up your teams packet.

COACHES & REFEREES NEEDED!

If you are interested in coaching your child's team, please check the box at the bottom of your child's registration form. **Returning Coaches from Fall 09 submitting registrations for a team, do not need to include a registration fee for their child.** If you are requesting to be a new coach, please include payment for your child's fee, if you are selected as Coach, you will be refunded your payment.

As part of the risk management process, JCPRD (the "District") checks criminal history records on individuals for employment with the District, including seasonal hires and volunteers who will work with children, individuals with disabilities and/or persons with frail and fragile physical circumstances or preconditions, or other circumstances as the District deems necessary. Referees must be 14 years of age or older.
