RE: Practice Field Permits Spring 2010

Thanks for your volunteer time! I hope your season has been a fun one and that the children enjoyed playing this Fall, have improved their skills and are looking forward to our Spring 2010 season.

If you are planning to coach again during the Spring 2010 season begin thinking about your practice schedule and make your day/time/field requests early!

As always, we do our very best to accommodate your requests. We have very limited field space. We will pencil you in, first come/first served, as we hear from you. Emails are the best way to make your requests quickly. Please provide a first and second choice (day/field/time) for your practice requests.

Because our league play takes place on Saturdays and Sundays we assign practice times on weekdays only for the following time slots for Stoll Park:

4-5:30 pm, 5:30-6:30 pm, 6:30-8 pm

As a rule we assign one practice time per team per week. When requested we may add a second slot for teams grades 5-8 if possible, or extend the hour-long time slots, if possible. Our Stoll Park fields are assigned for grade level practices as follows:

Field A East and Field A West for 5th and 6th graders (two teams sharing field)

Field B East and Field B West for 7th and 8th graders (two teams sharing field)

Fields C and D for 3rd and 4th graders

Fields E for 2nd graders

F and G for 1st graders

We do not assign practice fields to Pee Wee teams.

We will not begin assigning practice fields until the beginning of February, when we know which fields are available for our use. We should also know by the middle of January which Shawnee Mission School District Fields are available for use.

But it is in your best interest to get your requests in early! Permits will be distributed at our March 6th coaches' meeting. Once you have your permit, please be sure to take it with you to all practices. You might also want to make a copy for your assistant coach to carry.
