Senior Rules:

Game Length: Games are scheduled for 7 innings or 60 minutes. Teams are limited to 5 runs per inning except for the final inning as declared by the umpire under the following conditions: With 10 minutes playing time remaining, the umpire will state that the current inning will be completed and the next inning will be the last and only unlimited—run inning. In the event of extra innings because of a tie game those too are unlimited run-innings. If more than a 10 run difference occurs (visitors being ahead) then flip flop rule will be in forced. Home team will become visitors and visa versa.

Home Run Rule: 3 homeruns per game. All homeruns after that will be an out.

Scoring Plate: Players running home must cross the scoring plate. If they cross the home plate they are ruled out. This is a force out; catcher cannot tag out the runner once they have crossed the commitment line.

Balls and Strikes: 1 and 1 count when coming to bat and will be given a courtesy foul.

Batters and Runners: Teams can bat up to 20 batters for their lineup. Teams are allowed to have runners for players that have reached the base. These sub runners can only run for someone once per inning. If the runner is on base at the time they are to bat, he will be out on the base but allowed to bat.

Pitcher Protection Rule: If a pitcher is struck by a batted ball while within the pitchers box (2ft by 6ft and any part of the pitcher is within that box) and at the umpire's discretion the pitcher was trying to protect themselves from injury the batter is out and dead ball in affect. Runners do not advance. If the pitcher is outside the box the ball is in play and this rule is not in affect.

Tournament follows SSUSA softball rules

Pitching arch is 6' to 12'

No warm up balls on field after 1st inning.
