JCYS LEAGUE – Grade 1-4 GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION: Thomas S. Stoll Memorial Park Sports Complex, 12500 west 119th St. Overland Park KS (See Map and Game Schedule for Fields).

SOCCER BALL: Grades 1 through 4 will use a size 4 soccer ball.

PICTURE DAY: Once picture dates are set, coaches will be notified. Coaches should receive order forms well before picture day and should be handing these out before picture day. Johnson County does receive an incentive for pictures purchases which help to maintain the Youth Soccer Program. EQUIPMENT: Players must wear shin guards covered by long socks. Soccer shoes are optional. Baseball or Football cleats are not acceptable since they have toe cleats which are not allowed in Soccer. (These can be cut off). No jewelry may be worn. This includes earrings in newly pierced ears. Earrings covered by bandages are not allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** This is a USSF Rule.

GAME DATES: Saturday and/or Sundays. Games may be scheduled on weeknights if rainouts occur.

SCHEDULES / RAINOUTS: Schedules will be posted at www.jcprdsoccer.com when finalized. Approximately 1 week before games begin. Coaches and parents are asked to **check schedules on a weekly basis** for rescheduled games.

AWARDS: All players will receive an award at the end of the season. Coaches will be notified of pick up time for team awards at the Coach Shed at Stoll Park.

GAME TIMES: (See Schedule) GAME TIME is STARTING TIME. Game consists of two 25-minute halves.

PRACTICES: Teams are allowed one practice per week at Stoll Park or a SMSD field. Coaches will request a day and time preference and the league will then schedule practices based on the coach's request.

REFRESHMENTS: A Team Assistant may schedule parents to bring drinks and snacks for after the game. Glass bottles are not allowed.

CONCESSIONS: Due to low interest, we currently do not have anyone scheduled to offer concessions.
