JCYS LEAGUE – Grades 5-8 GENERAL INFORMATION

Grades 5-6 play 8 v 8 with 16 players max on roster
Grades 7-8 play 11 v 11 with 18 players max on a roster

SOCCER BALL: U11/U12 (Grade 5 & 6) Boys/Girls will use a size 4 Soccer Ball.
U13/U14 (Grades 7-8) Boys /Girls will use a size 5 soccer ball.

EQUIPMENT: All players must wear shin guards, completely covered by socks. Soccer shoes are optional.

GAME DATES: Saturday and/or Sunday Games. Games may be scheduled on weeknights if rainouts occur.

AWARDS: All players will receive an award at the end of the season. Coaches will be notified when they are available to pick up.

GAME TIMES: (See Schedule) GAME TIME is STARTING TIME. U11 & U12 play 30 minute halves and U13 & U14 play 35 minute halves.

PRACTICES: Coach will request day and time preference and league will assign teams to a certain location and time, based upon coach's request. Teams can practice twice a week if enough field space is available.

REFRESHMENTS: A Team Assistant may schedule parents to bring drinks and snacks for after the games. Glass bottles are not allowed. Concessions will be sold at Stump Park location only

CONCESSIONS: Due to the low interest we currently do not have anyone scheduled to offer concessions at Stoll Park.
