PEE WEE SOCCER General Info

8 Players per team with 4 vs 4 format with no goalie and volunteer coaches.

CLINIC ROUTINE:

- A. Start every session with a short slow run to warm muscles, followed by stretching out and exercise (5 minutes).
- B. Skill Training: Teaching and reviewing soccer fundamentals (20 minutes).
 1. Kicking the ball.
 2. Stopping the ball.
 3. Dribbling.
 4. Passing drills.
 5. Goalie drills.
 6. Throw-in.
- C. Scrimmage Games (2-12 minute halves).
 1. Positions on the Field.
 2. Passing patterns.
 3. Offense & Defense.

SOCCER BALL: This age group uses a size 3 ball.

EQUIPMENT: All players must wear shin guards covered by long socks. Soccer shoes are optional. Baseball or Football cleats are not acceptable since they have toe cleats which are not allowed in soccer. These can be cut off. No jewelry may be worn. This includes earrings in newly pierced ears. Earrings covered by bandages are not allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** This is a USSF Rule.

GAME/PRACTICE DATES: Six Saturdays and/or Sundays. Games may be scheduled on weeknights if rainouts occur.

SCHEDULES / RAINOUTS: Schedules will be posted at www.jcprdsoccer.com tentatively one week prior to start of games. **Coaches and parents are asked to check schedules on weekly basis, each Friday for any changes or rescheduled games.**

REFRESHMENTS: A Team Assistant helps schedule parents to bring drinks and snacks. Glass is not allowed at the Park.

CONCESSIONS: Due to low interest, at this time we do not have anyone schedule to offer concessions at Stoll Park.

AWARDS: All receive an award at the end of the season. Coaches will be notified of pick up time for team awards at the Coach Shed at Stoll Park.
