ANNUAL PERMITS

Permits issued and valid from the date of issue through the end of the current year.

AP = Antioch Park, HP = Heritage Park, KCP = Kill Creek Park, SMP = Shawnee Mission Park

Maps showing locations where activities are allowed will be provided with your permit.

Archery Permit

- The Archery Range is located in Shawnee Mission Park
- The use of bows and arrows is restricted to designated areas, and then only by persons who hold a valid District Archery Range Permit; provided, however, no such permit shall be required for children 12 years of age or younger when accompanied by an adult who has been issued a valid District Archery Range Permit.
- The use of broadhead arrows, razor-type arrows, and crossbows shall be prohibited within the boundaries of any District Facility.

Boating Permit

- No gasoline motors allowed.
- A valid District Boat Permit shall be required prior to placing any watercraft on District Facility waters. Boat permits shall be issued to both residents and non-residents of Johnson County, Kansas.
- Privately owned watercraft shall be restricted to Shawnee Mission Park Lake, Heritage Park Lake, Kill Creek Park Lake and designated sections of Streamway Parks System.

Fishing Permit

- In addition to State of Kansas licensing requirements, a valid District Fishing Permit shall be required for all persons fishing upon or within any District Facility who are 16 years of age or older, except that residents of Johnson County, Kansas who are 65 years of age and older shall not be required to obtain a District Fishing Permit. Persons who are required to have said Permits shall have them in their possession while engaged in fishing or in possession of fish while within the boundaries of any District Facility.

Metal Detector Permit

- Use of Metal Detectors are prohibited in the following District locations:
 - Memorial Arboretum at Antioch Park
 - All District Athletic Fields
 - Shawnee Mission Park and Kill Creek Park Beaches
 - (including swimming areas)

- The Theatre in the Park Bowl that is fenced off within SMP
- Ernie Miller Nature Park
- Sunflower Nature Park
- Mildale Farm
- TimberRidge Adventure Camp

Model Rocket Permit (INDIVIDUAL)

- Please adhere to Fire Ban signs when posted at the entrance to the parks.
 - Model Rocket launching is prohibited during fire bans.

Remote Control Vehicle

- Heritage Park – the Marina parking lot or Softball parking lot (if there are no on-going softball games).
- Antioch Park – the lower parking lot near Shelter #3.
- Kill Creek Park – the eastern portion of the Marina parking lot.
- Shawnee Mission Park – the eastern most portion of the far east parking lot on 80th Terrace or the northern most portion of the Marina parking lot.

Remote Control Boats and Sailboats

- No Gasoline Engines Allowed
- You may operate your battery-powered, remote-controlled **boats** in the following areas:
 - Shawnee Mission Park Small Lakes
 - Heritage Park Lake
 - Kill Creek Park – east end of the lake from the Marina
 - Antioch Park – both lakes
- You may operate your battery-powered, remote-controlled **sailboat(s)** at Heritage Park Lake, along the dam from the spillway and northeast to the Marina during the permit year.
- We ask that anytime you are using your boat(s) that you are considerate of other park patrons, especially those who are using the lake areas for fishing.

Line-Controlled Aircraft

- Line-controlled aircraft are permitted in Shawnee Mission Park ONLY. The specific area is on the south side of the park and is shown on the SMP Map.
