## MEMORIAL TREES

**Memorial Trees** can be planted at any of the District's beautiful parks. The person requesting a memorial tree should submit a written request accompanied by a donation of **\$150**.



See "PAYMENT." The District Forester, Facility Manager & Donor will collectively determine location for the tree.

Trees can also be requested for planting at Tomahawk Hills or Heritage Park Golf Courses. This was established to serve as a means for the public to recognize deceased golfing friends, partners or family members. Undesignated monetary contributions can also be made to the golf courses, which assist in ongoing improvements and special projects.

## MEMORIAL NAMEPLATES

A **Memorial Nameplate** can be ordered for placement on a Memorial Plaque (displayed within Antioch Park, Heritage Park, Kill Creek Park, Shawnee Mission Park and Tomahawk Hills Golf Course) for **\$120**.

Payment should accompany a written request. See "PAYMENT."



## ROSE GARDEN MEMORIALS

### Memorial Rose Bush

donations can be requested for the Helen S. Cuddy Memorial Rose Garden in Antioch Park. Donor should submit a written request accompanied by a minimum donation of **\$30**. See "PAYMENT." Undesignated monetary contributions can also be made to the "Rose Garden Fund,"



which funds the ongoing maintenance of this beautiful, enduring garden. The District will be responsible to purchase and plant the appropriate color of rose bush to coordinate with existing bushes.

## MEMORIAL BENCHES

The person requesting a **memorial bench** should submit a written request accompanied by the appropriate donation. See "PAYMENT." Two types of benches are available. The first option is a **Contour Bench**, which is **\$480**.



The second option, the **Trailside Bench**, is **\$360**. Prices for both benches include installation and main-

tenance. Both benches have a black powder-coated steel frame and are 6' long with 2" x 4" Resinwood slats. They are surface-mounted with anchor bolts on a 4' x 6' concrete slab. These designs were selected for their durability, ease of maintenance and uniformity throughout the District's parks & golf courses. District staff maintain the memorial benches on a similar interval as the standard park benches. The Superintendent of Parks and Golf Courses, Landscape Architect, Facility Manager, and Donor will collectively determine a location for the bench.



An engraved brass name plaque with the name of the person being memorialized can be installed onto a memorial bench for an additional **\$120**.



The plaque will be mounted into a recessed pocket, routed into a recycled plastic slat on the bench. District staff replace broken or vandalized name plaques at no additional charge.

## MEMORIAL TREES FOR PETS

A tree to memorialize your dog can be planted in designated areas within the dog off-leash areas at Heritage Park, Kill Creek Park, Shawnee Mission Park and Stoll Park. A written request should be submitted accompanied by a donation of **\$150**. See "PAYMENT." The memorial tree is planted and maintained by District staff. Trees to memorialize other pets are also available.

*Memorial Trees, Bushes, Benches and Plaques are a way to provide a timeless remembrance.*

## PAYMENT

All payments should accompany a written request that includes the requestor's name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, and the full name of the person being memorialized, if applicable. Payment should be in the form of cash (to be paid in person to obtain a receipt) or check made out to:
