



SAFE PRACTICE RECOMMENDATIONS

Dear Renters,

In accordance with Johnson County recommendations for safe operations, New Century Fieldhouse is open. We are committed to providing our patrons a safe experience by implementing the following measures:

Social Distancing: All participants and spectators are encouraged to keep 6 feet of distance between themselves and others from a different household.

Masks: Masks should be worn by everyone entering/leaving the facility. Spectators, coaches, and facility staff members should always wear a mask. Players may remove their mask during game play. If a coach is actively participating in the practice, they are not required to wear their mask during that time frame. Players should wear a mask while entering and leaving their court.

Physical Contact: Physical contact should be limited to what is necessary to play the game. Sportsmanship should take place in a touchless manner.

Court/Field Capacities: To encourage physical distancing. We ask that you limit your practices to the following guidelines. **VB/Half Court** - 15 participants; **Full Court** - 30 participants; **Full Soccer Field** - 45 participants; **1/3 Soccer Field** - 15 participants.

Schedule: Practice times should be staggered, and/or extra time should be scheduled between practices to ensure staggered groups leaving and entering the facility.

Arrival/Departure: Please make sure participants are not arriving early for practice. We want to try and limit groups interacting as much as possible. Make sure your team arrives on time and leaves after practice. Groups should not "hang out" in the building before/after their practice. If you need to have a team meeting after practice, please feel free to use the outdoor space or the gazebo area for these meetings.

Spectators: To allow for adequate social distancing, spectator numbers should be limited to one per participant if possible. Those feeling ill or belonging to a vulnerable population are asked to stay home. To minimize overlap of user groups, spectators should not enter the facility more than 5 minutes prior to practice time. When games are finished, all spectators should be asked to promptly leave the facility.

Seating: Spectators are encouraged to bring their own seating. If bleachers are used, 6 feet of distance should be maintained from those from other households.
