Tips to Avoiding Scams and Reporting

The Three Golden Rules



Stay scam-free with these three golden rules:

- ✓ **Slow it down**
Take your time and ask questions to avoid being rushed into a bad situation.
- ✓ **Spot check**
Always look up the bank, agency or organization that's supposedly calling and get in touch directly.
- ✓ **Stop! Don't send**
No reputable person or agency will ever demand payment on the spot—especially not gift cards.

Even Medical Information...



Medicare, or someone representing Medicare, will only call and ask for personal information in these situations:

A Medicare health or drug plan can call you if you're already a member of the plan. The agent who helped you join can also call you.

A customer service representative from 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) can call you **if you've called** and left a message or a representative said that someone would call you back.

if someone calls you and asks for your Medicare Number or other personal information, hang up and call us at 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227).

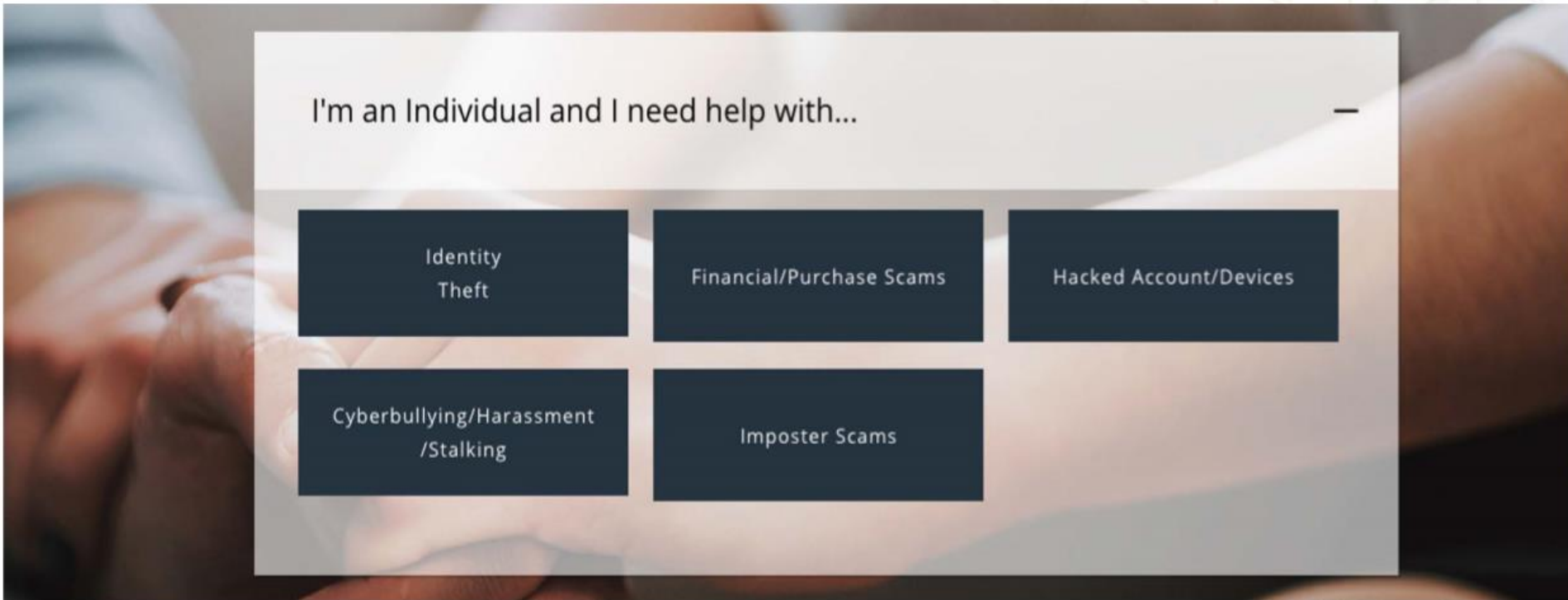
