Smaller series include newspaper articles primarily documenting the landmark *Webb v School District 90* case, as well as a small printed matter series, a correspondence file, and a series of school play programs from Lincoln Grade School, and associated artifacts.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The papers of Corinthian Nutter detail her profession as a teacher in Johnson County, Kansas and Olathe, Kansas; and her involvement in the *Webb v School District 90* case of 1948. Corinthian Nutter, referred to hereafter as Nutter, taught at the all black Walker Elementary in the South Park community of Merriam, Kansas. Nutter gave key testimony about the condition of that school during the *Webb v School District 90* case. This testimony helped to desegregate School District 90 in 1949. This case also paved the way for the desegregation case *Brown v Topeka Board of Education*. Nutter taught for thirty-three years in Johnson County, Kansas and Olathe, Kansas. The Nutter papers contain six series: Educational Career, Lincoln Grade School Play Programs, Correspondence, Printed Matter, Newspaper Articles, and Photographs.

Series 1: *Educational Career* contains programs, certificates, awards, and meeting minutes. It includes Nutter's commencement programs from the 1950 Emporia State Bachelor's Degree graduation ceremony and 1956 Emporia State University Master's Degree graduation ceremony.³⁰ It includes teaching certificates issued by the State of Kansas in 1953 and 1964. The file also contains an award from the Jack & Jill Club of Johnson County "in celebration of Black History Month" on February 21, 1994. Finally, it holds handwritten minutes from the Lincoln School P.T.A. in 1957 and Westview School student council in 1962.

Series 2: *Lincoln Grade School Play Programs* includes play programs from Lincoln Grade School dating 1937-1954. Nutter's name appears on the programs 1952, 1953, 1954. File contains two play scripts.

Series 3: *Correspondence* consists of cards, letters, and other enclosures documenting the professional and personal life of Corinthian Nutter. The materials date from 1948 to 1998. The bulk of this file contains thank you letters from students, teachers, newspapers, museums, and other institutions to Nutter for her interviews, presentations, and loan of pictures and documents. The file also contains rough drafts of letters written by Nutter, copies of letters from Nutter to parents of students, and invitations. The earliest letters in the file are a 1949 NAACP letter regarding Nutter's stipend while teaching Walker students from private homes, and a 1948 thank you letter from the students she taught at those homes.

Series 4: *Printed Matter* contains forms, programs, newsletters, and address lists. These materials date from 1938 to 2002. Programs are from the 1938 commencement ceremony of Olathe Senior High School and the Brown Memorial Park Dedication of 1985. The newsletters are both school newsletters and Johnson County newsletters. The address lists include student addresses and phone numbers and members of NAACP.

Series 5: *Newspaper Articles* includes newspaper clippings relating to Nutter's life and her involvement in *Webb v School District 90*. These date from 1949-2004 (some clippings with dates unknown) and come from a large variety of sources.

Series 6: *Photographs* includes black and white and color photographic prints of Nutter, her students, co-workers, and her friends. The most extensive collection of photographs is of student portraits from ca. 1960 to 1970. These are black and white and mostly unidentified.
