COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The records of the Student Congress, Shawnee Mission East High School, document the activities of this student organization in the first decade of the school's existence. The donor of the collection is a student who saved the records in 1975 when they were slated for disposal. The two main series consists of minutes and printed matter. Key material in the printed matter is a series of annual handbooks.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

SERIES 1: MINUTES; 1958-1968

Minutes are present for school years through this period (with one gap of 1966-1967). The minutes record the activities and efforts of the Student Congress. Agendas, rosters, committee reports, and other materials are typically present with each set of minutes. Committees in 1958 included: American Field Service, Girl's Intramural, Public Relations, Charters-Elections, School Improvement, Safety, Service, and Social.

SERIES 2: PRINTED MATTER; 1960-1975

Printed matter includes material dating after the timeframe of the minutes in the first series. Assorted reports are included, along with an incomplete set of handbooks from 1960 to 1971. The handbooks contain the constitution and by-laws, which, in turn hold rules regulation school elections (including homecoming queen), and school activities (such as dances).
