The Sharp Family papers and mementoes document the lives of the Sharp family of Johnson County, KS. The papers were originally a part of several scrapbooks put together by Janet Sharp. Many of the scrapbooks, dating from 1959-1976, were assembled using old *Saturday Evening Posts* to hold assorted loose papers. Small amounts of such loose papers form the legal documents, and printed matter series.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Sharp Family Papers document key moments in the lives of Sharp family members. It is a collection of family memorabilia dating from 1855-1976, with the bulk from 1967-1970. The Sharps were involved in local politics, high society, local schools, and traveled extensively. The collection is organized chronologically, as originally by Janet Sharp. It is composed of the loose materials found between the pages of the *Saturday Evening Post* and some miscellaneous family documents. The collection maintains this original chronology with an imposed organization of materials by subject under each year. There are 3 series in the collection in addition to photographs and accessioned objects. Most of the documents relate to family members Janet and Clifford Sharp, and their children; Stuart, Stanley, and Jandy. Other less represented family members in the collection are Tillman B. Sharp and Henry A. Maxwell, Perry Sharp, Hazel Sharp, and Shombi Sharp.

Tillman Sharp moved to Jackson County in 1856 with his wife Demarious and two children. Mose, a child of Tillman, was the father of Perry M. Sharp. Perry Sharp and Mary Wells Sharp were the parents of Clifford and Hazel Sharp. Hazel Sharp was a teacher at Prairie Elementary School and lived at the Sharp family farm at 135th and Mission. Clifford Sharp owned "Haskins, Sharp, & Ordelheide," a sanitary engineering firm. He was elected to, and served on, the Johnson County Water District No. 1 board; attended KU, University of Minnesota, and Harvard; and was a pilot who owned a Cessna. He married Janet Wilkinson. Janet Wilkinson Sharp was a graduate of KU, had 3 children, and was a housewife. The children of Janet and Clifford are Stanley, Stuart, and Jandy. The children attended grade school at Prairie Elementary and Indian Hills Jr. High. The boys attended high school at Pembroke Country Day School. Jandy attended Shawnee Mission East. The Sharp children participated in many activities including theater, YMCA, scouts, sports, and choir. The Sharp family took many trips and had a cabin in Green Mountain Falls, Colorado where they stayed a month each year.

The Legal documents series; 1854-1951, includes a small number of early financial papers of Tillman B. Sharp and Henry A. Maxwell, along with a small ledger recording farm income from 1946. Several folders contain Johnson County tax receipts and other financial records, with the last material relating to the purchase of a house in Prairie Village.

Printed matter contains a 1930 holiday advertisement from Emery, Bird, Thayer, notes in a booklet from the 1945 honeymoon of Janet and Clifford Sharp, a booklet about menopause.

The Scrapbook Materials Series; 1959-1976, is related specifically to the Janet and Clifford Sharp family. The folders in this series are divided into 7 subseries; 1959-1960, 1961-1962, 1963-1964, 1965-1966, 1967-1968, 1969-1970, and 1971-1976. The folders within the subseries are organized by recurring categories for each as appropriate. There are six recurring categories. The first category is "Celebrations" which includes greeting cards and letters dealing with holidays, birthdays, graduations, and other festivities. The second category is "School items" which is a combination of documents from each of the schools attended by the Sharp children,

their school work, and miscellaneous school documents. The third category, "Social Clubs/Events," contains documents dealing with the social activities and events of both the Sharp parents and children. The fourth category, "Vacations," includes documents related to Sharp family trips, flights, in town, and vacations. The fifth category, "Politics," contains political memorabilia mostly attributed to Clifford Sharp (who was elected to the Johnson County Water Board) and James Pearson (a Sharp family friend who was a Kansas Senator). The sixth category, "Family Events; Miscellaneous," contains letters, health related documents, and miscellaneous family documents.

The Photographs Series includes 102 images of teacher Hazel Sharp, students, and other faculty of Prairie Elementary School from 1933-1941. Additional images are of the family farm and family events. All images were copied and returned.

The Accessioned Objects series includes items found within the scrapbooks.
